Session	Learning Objective(s)	Proposed Teaching Activities	Learning Outcomes	Resources
1.	All children will learn the Spanish words for five classroom objects.	 Sing the Greeting Song. Sing Rhyme 7. Practice counting 0-12 and practise activities based on consolidating these. Discuss the knowledge organisers for this unit. Recap previously taught vocabulary to do with friends and their ages. Complete the missing spaces activity. Children to practise their conversational skills using this previously taught vocabulary. Introduce and teach the Spanish words for five classroom objects. Complete call and response activities using flashcards and then work through the Guess the Classroom Object interactive game. Children to copy out the words for these classroom objects onto their worksheets. Sing the Goodbye Song. 	 All children will ask and answer a question about age in Spanish. Most children will be able to say the name of a classroom object in Spanish. Some children will be able to say five classroom objects in Spanish. Session	Learning Objective(s)	Proposed Teaching Activities	Learning Outcomes	Resources
2.	All children will learn ordinal numbers from first to fifth.	 Sing the Greeting Song. Greeting children and eliciting corrections to saying their names incorrectly, asking how they are. Discuss the two different ways Spanish uses to say 'I am' — permanent and temporary. Listen to a song '¿Estás hambriento? Sí, lo estoy' to illustrate the 'temporary I am' phrase. Recap previously taught Spanish words for five classroom objects. Play What's in the Bag/What's in my Pencil Case? Introduce ordinal numbers from first to third. Children to listen and order classroom objects from first to third. Children to write classroom objects next to ordinal numbers. Sing the Goodbye Song. 	 All children will begin to recognise ordinal numbers. Most children will use ordinal numbers to order classroom objects. Some children will write classroom objects in Spanish. Session	Learning Objective(s)	Proposed Teaching Activities	Learning Outcomes	Resources
3.	All children will learn and practise four colours in Spanish.	 Sing the Greeting Song. Greeting children and eliciting corrections to saying their names incorrectly. Sing Rhyme 7. Introduce and teach Spanish colours. Use colour cards to aid in the recognition of these colours. Discuss the pronunciation of the colours and how similarities to known Spanish words. Describe classroom objects using colours as adjectives at the end of a sentence. Children to complete worksheet identifying classroom objects and colouring them accordingly. Children to create their own sentences using prompts. Children to write the four colours in Spanish. Sing the Goodbye Song. 	 All children will be able to recognise the four different colours in Spanish. Most children will be able to say and identify the four different colours in Spanish. Some children will be able to spell the four different colours in Spanish. 	 Lesson PowerPoint Our Greeting Song, including Video (PP Slides 7-9) Lyrics for the Greeting Song – See Lesson 1

4.	All children will listen and respond to requests for classroom objects.	 Sing the Greeting Song. Sing the Spanish colours song and recap Spanish colours if necessary. Discuss the Spanish conversation. Children to find the Spanish versions of English phrases and sentences within this conversation. Children to complete the spot the mistake listening activity. Complete the Ceros y Cruces/Noughts and Crosses activity. Sing the Goodbye Song. 	 All children will recognise some pre-taught Spanish vocabulary through reading or listening. Most children will be able to understood which classroom objects are requested and what colour these might be. Some children will be able to recognise unknown Spanish vocabulary using a scaffold or prompt to help them. 5.	All children will explore the Spanish school system.	 Sing the Greeting Song. Sing Song - ¿Estás hambriento?. Complete the Ceros y Cruces/Noughts and Crosses Spanish numbers activity. Compare and contrast schooling in Spain with schooling in Britain. Learn about the different school year groups and how these are named in different countries from around the world. Children to discuss their age and year group with their peers. Sing the Goodbye Song. 	 All children will recall some facts about the Spanish school system. Most children will compare and contrast the Spanish school system with the British school system. Some children will understand how old a person is and what school year they are in. 6.	All children will consolidate and test their knowledge of classroom objects, colours and language learnt so far.	 Sing the Greeting Song. Sing Rhyme 7. Complete and then mark the end of unit quiz. Review the knowledge organisers. Complete pupil self-assessment forms. Children play a game, and then create their own Ceros y Cruces game based on vocabulary taught during this unit and the preceding ones. Sing the Goodbye Song. 	 All children will recall some of the Spanish words taught in this unit. Most children will be able to say and recognise the six taught colours in Spanish. Some children will be able to ask for a classroom object by colour.
